PRODUCTS: John W. McDougall Co. Inc., Nashville, Tenn., manufactured 4,500 square feet (418 m²) of 0.157-inch (4-mm) rainscreen composite system used on the wall and soffits.

FINE POINTS: The building was designed in the German autohaus architectural style for a high-end appearance. The existing warehouse was renovated into an updated service center while existing offices were demolished and replaced with a contemporary showroom. Metal panels were used on all soffits and on the metal-panel feature walls. The exterior wall also features a metal panel that accents the Mercedes logo.
